Role description

We are looking for a person who will go out with work parties, survey groups and to other places where Shropshire Wildlife Trust are working and record what's happening. You will also be required to visit our reserves and record what you see using video and still photography capturing wildlife, people, interesting features and recording sounds around the site to capture the essence of the place. Activities undertaken on work parties could include: fencing, lopping and sawing, undergrowth clearance, and pond or stream management. There would be the opportunity to take part in the activity if you wish in order to better understand what they are doing as well as documenting the activity where possible. The ability to be able to 'stage' photos would sometimes be necessary as well as to engage with the volunteers. You will need to be physically fit and enjoy being outdoors throughout the year. You'd need to be able to commit to one day a week - Wednesday, Thursday or Friday for approx. 6 months.

You'll undertake training to do with GDPR and protocol around permissions and SWT Safeguarding & Lone Working Policy.
