Role description

- Practical conservation work with our work parties on our reserves around Shropshire
- You'll be working as part of a friendly team going out onto reserves and carrying out practical tasks as part of the reserve management. Tasks could include scrub clearance using bow saws and loppers, fencing, putting in gates, burning brash etc.
- Most of the hard, physical work takes place from October to March and then the work changes and we require fewer numbers over the spring and summer months
- Our reserves are isolated, exposed and have no facilities. Travel time from Shrewsbury can be up to an hour
- You'll need to bring lunch, water and wear sensible outdoor clothing plus stout work boots
