

Covid-19 spreads in droplets from nose or mouth when an infected person coughs, sneezes or exhales	Staff, family, friends	Medium	Medium	When coughing or sneezing, staff will cover their mouth and nose with a tissue or sleeve (not hands) and dispose of tissues immediately and safely.
Covid-19 survives up to 72 hours on hard surfaces including post & packaging	Staff, family, friends	Medium	Low	Staff will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wash hands regularly

Regular washing of hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds is mandatory.

Covid-19 enters the body via droplets or touching contaminated surfaces and then touching eyes or mouth	Staff, family, friends	Low	Low	As above plus: Face masks are mandatory for travelling on all public transport and therefore if travelling in relation to work.
Staff become ill or symptomatic whilst working@home	Staff, family, friends	Medium	Low	If symptoms are seen (a new continuous cough, high temperature, loss of taste/smell) staff will follow government advice to self-isolate for 10 days and inform their line manager.
Other people within the home environment become ill or symptomatic whilst staff member is working@home	Staff, family, friends	Medium	Low	If symptoms are seen (a new continuous cough, high temperature, loss of taste/smell) staff will ensure other people will follow government advice to self-isolate for 14 days and their inform line manager.
Work@home staff occasionally visit office buildings for work	Staff, family, friends	Medium	Low	Reference will be made to the RA for People-Offices-All
Work@home staff visit external meeting venue (s)				Adherence to external 'host' RA requirements is mandatory. In the absence of an external RA, staff will adopt precautions outlined above. If using pool vehicles, adherence will be made to RA: Vehicles-Use-All
