Progress report 2019 to 2020

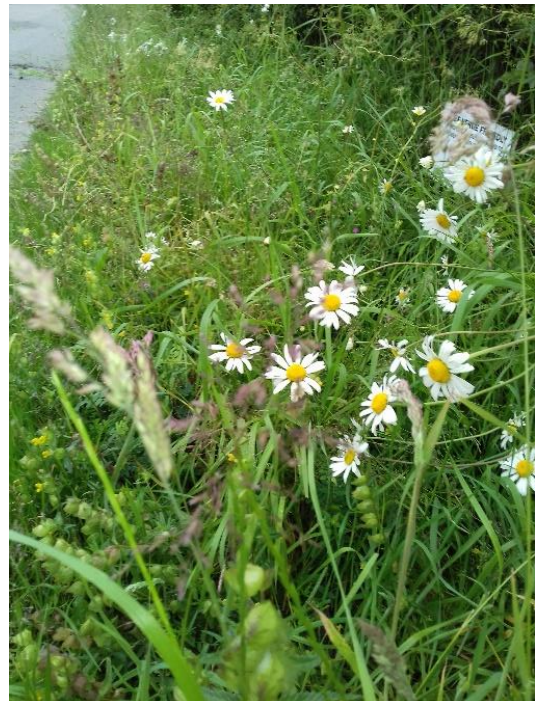
- Repeat of data collection of species on verges in Edgton has not been possible due to Covid-19 lockdown restrictions in 2020, but a few photographs from early 2020 below.
- Wild flower seed & plugs purchased/gathered and grown on by volunteers in Edgton Village.
 - Oxe-eye daisies
 - Primrose
 - Ladies Smock
 - Mallow
 - Agrimony
 - Knapweed
 - Foxgloves
 - Yellow rattle seed

These plugs and seed have now been planted in 3 specified sites to start to restore damaged verges.

1. Edgton village hall
2. A long newly created verge in Horderley following hedge laying, being used as a seed bed for future plants.
3. Edgton Village Green in Edgton Village centre
